EXPIRATION OF PERMIT

<p>A permit will expire and become null and void if work is not started within 180 days, or if work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after work has commenced. PERMITS ARE VALID FOR 12 MONTHS FROM DATE OF ISSUANCE. A PERMIT REMAINS VALID AS LONG AS WORK IS PROGRESSING AND INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED.</p>

24-HOUR NOTICE IS NEEDED FOR ALL INSPECTIONS. INSPECTIONS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED DURING REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS. WORK STARTED PRIOR TO OBTAINING A PERMIT ARE SUBJECT TO CHARGES OVER AND ABOVE THE PERMIT FEES.
