Allocation of Community Development Block Grant Funds

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, January 17, 2017 at 7:30 p.m., at the Ray Township Hall, 64255 Wolcott Road, Ray, MI 48096, a public hearing will be held to obtain the views of citizens concerning community development and housing needs, as required by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.

Ray Township will be receiving \$7500.00 in Community Development Block Grant Funds for Fiscal Year 2017 from the Macomb “Urban County” Program.

Federal guidelines require that the maximum priority be given to activities which primarily benefit low or moderate income families or which aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight. A variety of projects are eligible for community development funding. These include:

Physical (Brick and Mortar) Activities:

Acquisition of Real Property, Code Enforcement, removal of Architectural Barriers for Disabled People, Demolition and Building Clearance, Public Facilities, Infrastructure and other Improvements

Service Activities (samples):

Child Care, Health Care, Recreation Programs, Education Programs, Public Safety, Energy Conservation/Testing, Homeless Prevention, Senior Services, Drug Abuse Counseling & Treatment, Public Services

Citizens residing in blighted areas or low income persons are encouraged to participate in this process.
