In a continued effort to keep our citizens and first responders safe from COVID-19 the Ray Township Fire Department is asking everyone to use increased discretion when seeking emergency services. The Ray Township Fire Department will always immediately respond to emergencies.

GFL trash pick-up will continue as scheduled on Fridays. The Recycle Center will be postponed until further notice.
