Does your income fall below 150% of Area Median Income?*

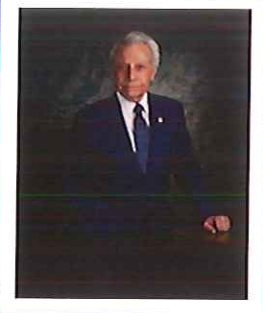
* A Macomb County Family of 4: \$120,000 or a Macomb County Family of 2: \$96,000.

You may be eligible to receive up to \$25,000 for:

- Property taxes
- Delinquent mortgage/housing expenses, escrow shortages and corporate advances
- Delinquent land contract payments, mobile home consumer loan payments or contracted park lot payments
- Condominium/homeowners association fees
- Homeowners insurances, hazard, flood or mortgage insurance
- Utilities and internet services
