Schedule of Application: Applications will take place between September 9-October 31, 2022.

Herbicide Locations: Locations may include, but are not limited to, sections of:

Chesterfield Township: William P Rosso, 21, 23, 24, 25, and 26 Mile, Hagen, Hobarth, Classic, Callens, Burdon, Baker, Altman, Sass, Foster, Bates, Chesterfield, Jefferson, Donner, and Berkshire.

Clinton Township: Dunham, 19 Mile, Cass, Canal Road, Sharkey, Dalcoma, Moravian, Little Mack, Metropolitan Parkway, and Stevenson.

Harrison Township: William P Rosso, Metropolitan Parkway, Executive, Perimeter, Venetian, and Prentiss.

Ray Township: 26, 27, 28, 29, 30 and 31 Mile, North, Romeo Plank, Indian Trail, Hartway, Teller, Broughton, Wolcott, and Kunstman.

Shelby Township: Hall Road, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, and 26 Mile, Hayes Road, Schoenherr, Jewell, Van Dyke, Mound, Ryan, and Dequindre.

City of Sterling Heights: 17, 18, and 19 Mile, Hall Road, Mound, Hayes, and Hannebauer Lane.

Washington Township: 26, 27, 28, 29, 30 and 31 Mile Roads, Schoenherr, Campground, Hayes, Jewell, Mt. Vernon, Kittle, Old Van Dyke, Mound, Dequindre, Inwood, and Macomb Orchard Trail.

Herbicides Planned for Use:

Aquaneat (glyphosate), Cygnet Plus (surfactant), and Blue Tracer Dye (marker).

Method of Application:

Applications will be foliar applied by vehicular mounted hand spray gun equipment. Individual plants will be carefully treated with backpack sprayers.

Re-Entry Restrictions: **Do not enter treated areas until the spray has dried.**
