

Upcoming Natural Gas Site Maintenance.

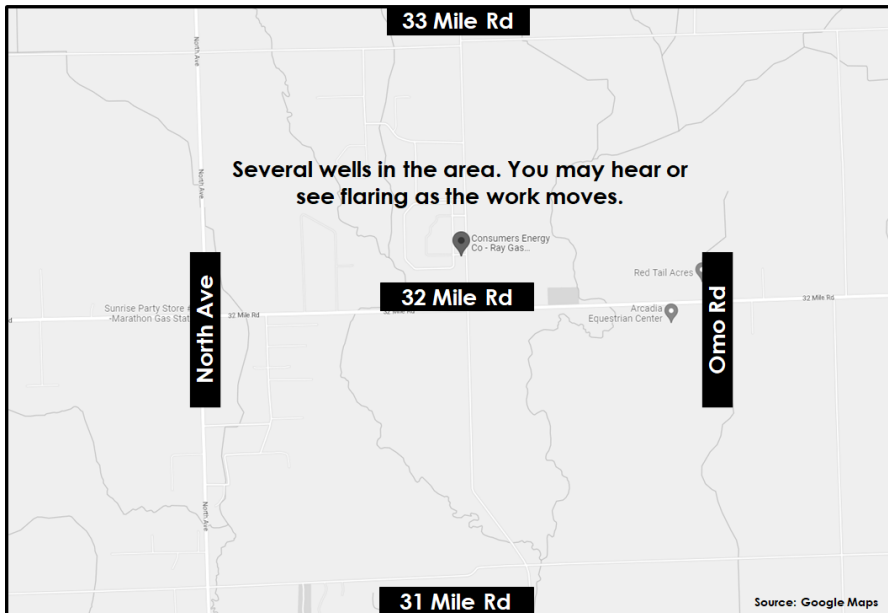
We do our best to provide customers with safe, reliable and affordable natural gas service, which includes updating and maintaining our underground gas storage infrastructure.

Traffic

An increase in work vehicles hauling equipment and supplies may periodically create slow traffic.

Flaring / Flame

During this routine maintenance work, some pressurized natural gas will rise from the open wells. To ensure the safety of nearby neighbors, our workers and the environment, this excess natural gas will be burned off in a controlled manner. This is called flaring, which you may see or hear anywhere within the provided map.

Flaring is a safe, common industry practice and is continuously monitored. Emergency officials have been notified of the activity.

Noise

You may hear flaring while our crews are working, which sounds like a blow torch. You also may hear construction equipment and on-site generators.
