Persons qualified to vote by absentee ballot in the New Haven Schools Special Election may vote in person in the Clerks office up to 4:00 PM, May 6, 2024. The Polls will be open at 7:00 AM and remain open until 8:00 PM on Election Day.

All precincts are handicap accessible. Voting instructions are available in alternative formats. Contact your Clerk's office for details. Please note that you will be asked to show ID when you check in. If you don't have one, you can still vote but will need to sign an affidavit of identity form if you do not have picture identification with you.

Accepted forms of identification: Michigan driver's license or state ID, driver's license or personal identification card issued by another state, federal or state government-issued photo identification, U.S. passport, Military ID with photo, student identification with photo from a high school or accredited institution of higher learning, Tribal identification card with photo.

**ELECTION DAY:** THE POLLS of said election will be open at 7:00 AM and will remain open until 8:00 PM of said day of election.
